- > IzG finds simple and light weight solutions for comfort

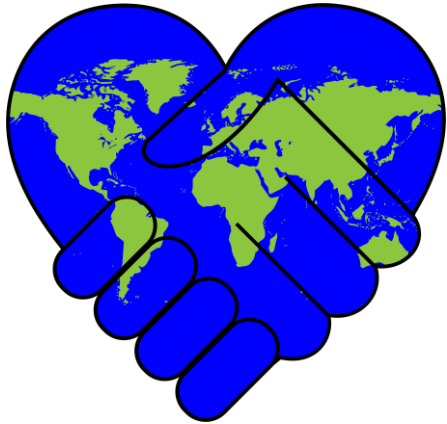
Increased comfort allows independence and sustainability
